**Public Plans Display for
Interstate 70 Yukon / Madison Interchanges
South Huntingdon, Sewickley and Hempfield townships, Westmoreland County**

Uniontown, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) will conduct a plan display to inform the public of the proposed reconstruction of Interstate 70 (I-70) at the Yukon (Exit 53) and Madison (Exit 54) interchanges located in South Huntingdon, Sewickley and Hempfield Townships, Westmoreland County.

The project includes revised interchange alignments which will address geometric, operational and safety issues. I-70 will be reconstructed and widened to include two (2) twelve (12) foot lanes in each direction, a ten (10) foot median and twelve (12) foot outside shoulders. Seven (7) structures will also be either replaced or rehabilitated as part of this project.

The purpose of this meeting is to present the proposed plans and gather input. PennDOT representatives, along with design consultants, will be available to answer questions.
