Change in Date for Smithton Pike to Close Interstate 70 at Route 31 Interchange Update South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County

Uniontown – PennDOT District 12 would like to update motorists on the Interstate 70 at Route 31 Interchange project. Currently, the contractor is clearing along the Interstate and Smithton Pike. During this part of the project, there will be no traffic restrictions on I-70 during the day -- only nighttime single lane closures will occur as necessary.

Smithton Pike will be closed on Monday 5/7/18. This closure is being implemented so that construction can occur. Smithton Pike will be re-aligned and the bridge over I-70 will be replaced during this closure. There will be an official signed detour route in place that uses Charlie's Road, Mendon Road and Route 31. This work will go until sometime late Spring 2019.

The contractor on this \$66.9 million project is Golden Triangle Construction Company, Inc. It has a tentative completion date in November 2020.

Motorists are always reminded to slow down and drive with caution when entering any work zone.
